


Goals

Each classroom has a blend of special needs students and "peer model" developing students. Peer model students pay a monthly tuition. The Hancock County ESC places students with special needs, and each school district places peer model students. If you have an interest in having your child attending as a peer model student please contact the elementary school office of the district in which you reside.

Referral

Call the Hancock County ESC (419-422-7525) for a free, multidisciplinary evaluation. Referrals can come from a variety of places including parents, doctors, or social services caseworkers.

Services

Preschool children who have a delay in development may be eligible for special services. Developmental delays can occur in any of these areas:

- Language (talking and understanding)
- Motor (walking and movement)
- Hearing
- Visual
- Adaptive
- Social/Emotional
- Cognitive (school readiness)

Staff

A State Certified Highly Qualified Preschool Education teacher and a State Certified Highly Qualified assistant facilitate each class. The total preschool special education team includes the teacher, assistant, speech/language pathologist, occupational therapist, physical therapist, preschool psychologist and an adaptive physical education teacher.
